He studied at Wheaton College, Michigan State University, Trinity Evangelical Divinity School, the University of Toulouse and the University of Paris. He has taught at Trinity since 1970. He has also taught at Northwestern University [Evanston, Illinois] as a Visiting Professor of History and at the Sorbonne [Paris] as a Visiting Professor of Religion. He is the author or editor of some twenty volumes. He also served as an editor at *Christianity Today*. John has a special interest in the history of Spiritual Awakenings and is praying that God will once again pour out His Holy Spirit in power upon this land. John and his wife Susan were married in the EFCA church of Keene, Nebraska. Susan went to school in Axtell. They have three children.
